Hunt Institute was dedicated in 1961 as the Rachel McMasters Miller Hunt Botanical Library, an international center for bibliographical research and service in the interests of botany and horticulture, as well as a center for the study of all aspects of the history of the plant sciences. By 1971 the Library's activities had so diversified that the name was changed to Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation. Growth in collections and research projects led to the establishment of four programmatic departments: Archives, Art, Bibliography and the Library.

Be it remembered, that at a regular term of the U.S. District Court of Territory of Hawaii held at Honolulu, Hawaii on the 31st day of May in the year of our Lord nonden hundred and thirteen, Joseph Francis Charles Rock who previous to his naturalization was a Subject of Austria at present residing at number 2366 Elia Rise St. Hon. Hawaii of Honolulu Territory of Hawaii having applied to be admitted a citizen of the United States of America pursuant to law, and the court having found that the petitioner had resided continuously within the United States for at least five years and in this Territory for one year immediately preceding the date of the filing of his petition, and that said petitioner intends to reside permanently in the United States had in all respects complied with the law in relation thereto, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon ordered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 31st day of May in the year of our Lord nonden hundred and thirteen and of our Independence the one hundred and thirty-seventh

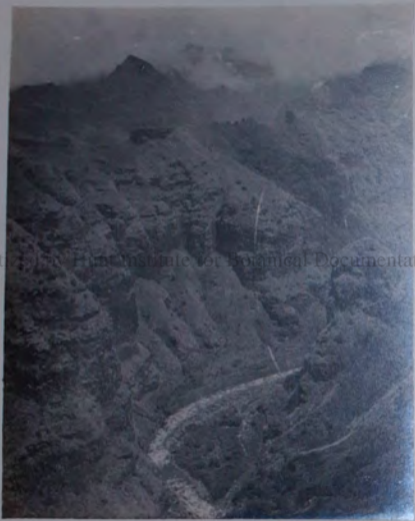
