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About the Institute

The Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation, a research division of Carnegie Mellon University, specializes in the history of botany and all aspects of plant science and serves the international scientific community through research and documentation. To this end, the Institute acquires and maintains authoritative collections of books, plant images, manuscripts, portraits and data files, and provides publications and other modes of information service. The Institute meets the reference needs of botanists, biologists, historians, conservationists, librarians, bibliographers and the public at large, especially those concerned with any aspect of the North American flora.

Hunt Institute was dedicated in 1961 as the Rachel McMasters Miller Hunt Botanical Library, an international center for bibliographical research and service in the interests of botany and horticulture, as well as a center for the study of all aspects of the history of the plant sciences. By 1971 the Library's activities had so diversified that the name was changed to Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation. Growth in collections and research projects led to the establishment of four programmatic departments: Archives, Art, Bibliography and the Library.

New Mex. I might or could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that my said Attorney shall lawfully do, or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

It is hereby agreed by T. G.
Schroeder and his wife Katharine
Schroeder that they will
sell to P. D. Stoops and Marcus

and \$445: to be paid in eight
months from the date of this agreement.
The property thus sold is described
as follows: commencing 10 ^{12 1/2 feet} rods from
the North East corner of the northeast
(40) forty of the southeast quarter of
Sect. 22 (twenty five) thence west
32 rods, thence south 19 ^{15 feet} rods, thence
east 32 rods, thence north 19 ^{and 15 feet} rods
to the place of beginning.
Thence east 47 (five) rods and 4 feet

thence south 19 rods ^{and 15 feet} east, thence
west 5 rods and 4 feet, thence
north 19 rods ^{and 15 feet} to place of
beginning, containing $4\frac{2}{3}$ acres
more or less. Situated in Sec. 25-
T₄ N. 21₄ R. 1 W. Salt Lake Meridian.

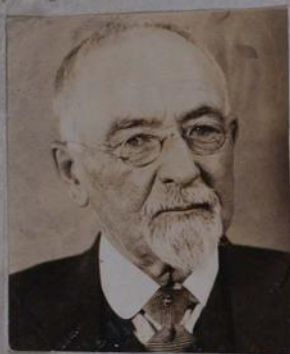
