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About the Institute

The Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation, a research division of Carnegie Mellon University, specializes in the history of botany and all aspects of plant science and serves the international scientific community through research and documentation. To this end, the Institute acquires and maintains authoritative collections of books, plant images, manuscripts, portraits and data files, and provides publications and other modes of information service. The Institute meets the reference needs of botanists, biologists, historians, conservationists, librarians, bibliographers and the public at large, especially those concerned with any aspect of the North American flora.

Hunt Institute was dedicated in 1961 as the Rachel McMasters Miller Hunt Botanical Library, an international center for bibliographical research and service in the interests of botany and horticulture, as well as a center for the study of all aspects of the history of the plant sciences. By 1971 the Library's activities had so diversified that the name was changed to Hunt Institute for Botanical Documentation. Growth in collections and research projects led to the establishment of four programmatic departments: Archives, Art, Bibliography and the Library.

THIS AGREEMENT, made this December 17, 1974, between
the Board of Control, a public corporation of the State of Florida, on behalf of
the University of Florida Press, hereinafter called "Publisher," and Wilson
Popenoe, hereinafter called "Author," Witnesseth:

I. The Author shall place in the hands of the Publisher the manuscript,
properly prepared for the Press, and materials from which illustrations, if needed,
can be made without redrawing, of a work to contain about _____,
provisionally entitled Guatemala: The Land of the Quetzal (New York, 1887) by
William T. Brigham

II. The Author represents and guarantees himself to be the author and sole
proprietor of said work; and he further guarantees and continuously warrants that
said work is in no way whatever a violation of any copyright, and contains nothing
scandalous or libelous. The Author further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless
the Publisher against any suit, judgment, claim, or demand that may be made, in-
stituted, or obtained against the Publisher by reason of infringement of any copy-
right resulting from the sale, delivery, or possession by the Publisher of the
work covered by this Agreement, or by reason of said work, or any part thereof,
being libelous.

III. The Author grants to the Publisher, the Publisher's successors, and
assigns, the exclusive right, subject to the conditions of this Agreement, to
print and publish and sell said work. The Publisher shall publish said work with-
in a reasonable time. The Publisher shall keep said work in print as long as the
Publisher shall deem expedient. The Publisher shall have the exclusive right to
take out copyright in the name of the Board of Commissioners of State Institutions

of Florida upon approval of said Board in accordance with sections 272.01 and 272.02 Florida statutes, for the use and benefit of the University of Florida Press, but unless specifically agreed in writing the Publisher shall not be responsible for taking out copyright outside the United States. The Publisher shall also have the right upon approval of the Board of Commissioners of State Institutions of Florida to effect any renewals of copyright, and the right to any assistance from the Author, or his heirs, essential thereto.

IV. The Author agrees to verify all important statements, quotations, and citations appearing in his manuscript; submit clean typescript copy in final form, retaining carbon copy; recommend definite title; write preface, prepare bibliography; compile index; select (with the approval of the Publisher) maps, graphs, and illustrations; and read all galley proofs.

V. The Publisher agrees to pay the Author royalties as follows: Beginning with the first copy sold, a 10 per cent royalty on the net return from sales. No royalty shall be paid on copies given away or sold at less than cost of manufacture.

VI. The Author agrees to purchase no copies of said work at a total cost of nothing.

VII. The Publisher may sell, over the Publisher's own imprint or over another's imprint, copies or editions of said work for foreign publication or under state contract or otherwise. The Publisher may arrange for English, Canadian, or other foreign or domestic editions from duplicate plates or from independent typesetting, or for domestic or foreign mechanical reproduction, over the Publisher's own imprint or over another's imprint, or for translation into a foreign language, and in which event the Publisher shall pay the Author, in lieu

of royalty, one-half of the profits from such transactions. For the publication for value of extracts from said work, the Publisher shall pay the Author one-half of the receipts.

VIII. For alterations which the Author makes in proof after the type has been set up in conformity with the manuscript, he shall pay to the Publisher all charges in excess of 10 per cent of the total cost of said alterations.

IX. Whenever called upon by the Publisher, the Author shall prepare matter for new editions of the book. In case of desiring a new edition, or new editions, after the Author's death or disability, the Publisher may engage competent persons to prepare them and charge the expense against the Author's royalty. Unless otherwise agreed, the plates shall be arranged for such new editions at the expense of the Publisher, but the Publisher shall not bear the expense of inserting any amendment unless the Publisher considers it important enough to justify insertion.

X. The Author agrees that during the life of this Agreement he will not, without the consent of the Publisher, furnish to any other publisher any work on the same subject of such extent and character as to conflict with the sale of the said work.

XI. The Publisher agrees to use reasonable care and diligence in the protection of any physical property belonging to the Author placed in the Publisher's hands by the Author under the terms of this Agreement and further agrees to use the same degree of care in the protection of said property as the Publisher exercises in the protection of property of a similar character belonging to said Publisher. The Publisher shall be responsible for the protection of said property against damage by fire or water or its loss only to the amount that said Author

shall request said Publisher in writing to insure said property at the Author's own expense.

XIII. Settlements of accounts, up to each January and July, shall be had on the first day of each January and July respectively subsequent. Whenever the semiannual sales fall below ten copies, no accounting shall be had until the next semiannual settlement after the sales unaccounted for aggregate as many as ten copies. The Author may not, without the Publisher's written consent, assign any interest in this Agreement; the Publisher may assign this Agreement or any interest therein, and thereupon be relieved of all further liability hereunder, but may not sell this Agreement as an entirety without giving the Author the prior right to purchase the same at the price offered.

In Witness Whereof, the Board of Control has caused this Agreement to be signed in its name by its Executive Director and its Seal to be affixed, and the Author has hereunto set his hand and seal, the day and year first above set out.

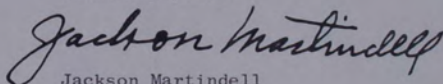

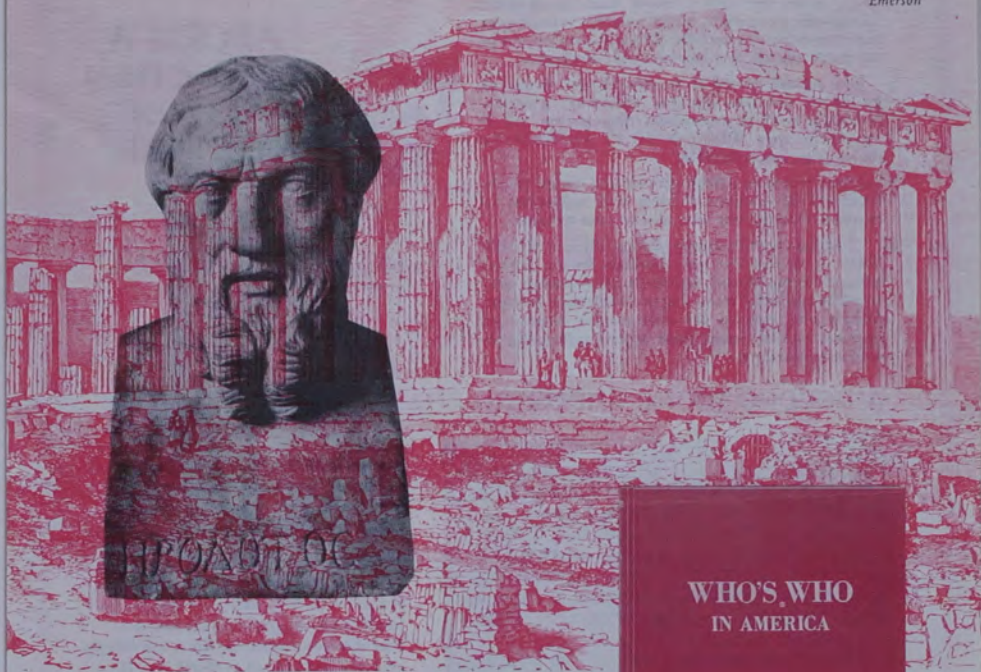

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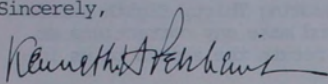
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
