Greetings to you Alumni:

Many of you have received the Juniper and will be informed of some of the happenings about school and the doings of your classmates. This letter will supplement that and provide even more detailed information.

This year 34 more men were added to your numbers, 28 of whom completed their undergraduate work and 6 received Master of Science degrees. Of the latter, 4 were in the field of wildlife management and 2 were in range. This brings to 342 the degrees granted at this school, 146 in forestry, 126 in range and 70 in wildlife. Of these, 4 are deceased.

We have analyzed the returns from the alumni questionnaires in order to complete the Society report. This has furnished some interesting data, about employment and other items although this is a matter which is difficult of enumeration because of the steady movement of men into the Army. As of the year of the report there were employed 91 in forestry, 191 in other conservation fields and 63 others. This picture has changed materially until at present the men are distributed about as occurs in the following table. It will probably be wrong by the time I get it stenciled.

However, there were fewer returns than last year and this report will just about bring the association's resources down to base level. If this is worthwhile to you, remember that your dollars make it possible. We can still use yours.

One of the problems that confronts us will be in keeping track of you. You can assist in this by reporting in occasionally about yourselves and others whom you may have met or heard from. Your assistance in this matter will be appreciated.

To all of you, especially those in the armed forces, the best of luck. We'll cheer for you from here until perchance we may meet you there.
