Dear Father Mourterde,

About a month ago I sent you plant specimens collected from Jordan during 1955. I hope that the parcel reached you safely. Specimens are placed between newspapers and the collection number of each specimen is indicated on the same papers.

Enclosed I am sending you the list of localities and dates of collections according to the collecting numbers arranged in a numerical sequence. You may find several duplications of specimens in this shipment but as it will be noticed in the attached list they are collected from different localities. As you desired to have duplications I tried to include them in the shipment which may be useful to determine the natural range and variation of the species.

You were particularly interested in having specimens of Acacia, Haloxylon, Tamarix etc. I tried to include them in the shipment as much as I could. However I wasn't able to send you Moringa aptera Gaertn. since I did not have duplicate specimens of this shrub. I keep in mind your other requests and I will be glad to collect them for you as soon as I can.

I wonder if you had a chance to examine the specimens of this last shipment. I shall be very obliged if you kindly send me the list of identifications according to the collection numbers when you can.

I was in Teheran to attend the meeting of Near East Forestry Commission during the first week of this month. I stopped over in Beiruth on my return trip to Amman and I tried to contact you several times over the telephone. Unfortunately I failed in my calls since I was told that you were not at the university that time. However I shall try to visit you when I go to Beiruth again.

My wife joins me in sending you our best wishes and kind regards.
